Fee: US\$ 3000

- * Limited number of scholarships are available.
- * Fee does not include airfare, visa fees and pocket money.
- * Schools are strongly encouraged to send one faculty member along with the students, to develop long-term projects between participating institutions.

* Schools that send 3 full-fee paying students will be eligible to send 1 teacher/ student free of course fee (airfare & visa fees will need to be paid for).

* Schools that send 6 full-fee paying students will be eligible to send 1 teacher/ student free of course fee + airfare.

Course structure

* **Week 1:** Theoretical discussions & workshops from experts in the field of cross/inter cultural performance.

* **Week 2:** Community projects with the Sidi (African Indian) community.

* **Week 3:** Street performances exploring what it means to use culture as a tool in dialogue & exchange.

The essence of this course is to enable participants to delve into how, in our globalized world, we create sustainable & nuanced connections with neighbouring nations. Through partnerships made during the three weeks, participating institutions will find that they have built a platform for long term, cross- cultural collaborations.
